Role Summary

- Managed and optimized Kubernetes workloads, CI/CD pipelines, and Helm charts while collaborating closely with development teams to troubleshoot production issues.
- Maintained Azure infrastructure with Terraform and operated observability and logging systems (Prometheus, Thanos, Grafana, Loki, Tempo, Alloy).
- Onboarded, configured, and maintained developer and data engineering tooling with SSO integration, scalable deployments, and lifecycle management.
- Supported, extended, and integrated data-platform tooling for Project Nightingale with internal applications, including Argo Workflows, Spark, Trino, Nessie, and JupyterHub.

Key Achievements

- Unified and standardized all deployment Helm charts across the organization, improving maintainability, consistency, and onboarding speed for engineering teams.
- Led the organization-wide migration from Bitbucket Pipelines to ArgoCD for all application deployments, then optimized and stabilized the platform to reliably deploy 150+ applications across 30 clusters. Educated teams on GitOps workflows and best practices during the transition.
- Revitalized and optimized the observability stack (Prometheus, Thanos, Grafana), consolidated two fragmented legacy ELK Stack environments into one with a full migration and optimization, and later collaborated with the platform team on migrating the logging platform to Loki.
- Took ownership of the infrastructure and DevOps track within Project Nightingale, integrating data platform components (Argo Workflows/Events, Spark, Trino, Nessie, RabbitMQ, MinIO, DataHub, JupyterHub). Designed event-driven workflows, developed custom Python tooling for Spark-on-Kubernetes standardization, and optimized resources while collaborating with stakeholders to deliver scalable solutions.
- Led the migration from Ingress NGINX to Envoy Gateway as part of the organization-wide transition to Gateway API, improving reliability, flexibility, and security of traffic management.
- Collaborated with the Platform team on adopting Talos for production on-premise environments (Proxmox, OpenStack), and on onboarding Cilium and Kyverno across our environments.
